The International Project Discovery Forum (IPDF) is the 4-day industry section of the Los Angeles Greek Film Festival. Now in its seventh edition, IPDF is a Los Angeles pioneer in the promotion of international independent film

development. Utilizing the innumerable resources that exist, the goal is to create a bridge between two very different worlds – those of American and Greek/Balkan independent cinema.

For IPDF participants, the development lab culminates in an audiovisual presentation by each project's representative (s) before a jury of professionals. The IPDF awards will be presented during LAGFF's Orpheus Awards Ceremony on June 9, 2019 at The Egyptian Theatre.

"IPDF provides a venue where dialogue is encouraged and creative collaborations are formed," explains IPDF Director Araceli Lemos. "We build a network of creative professionals from Greece, the Balkans and the U.S. that share the desire to preserve film as an artistic expression, always searching for new ways of story telling through image and sound."
